**RE: November 28, 2007 Notice of Intention to Issue Advisory Re. Autonomy Keyview**

Mr. Kristensen:

We are in receipt of your email from earlier today, and it seems to miss the point. It is not us, but rather libel and falsehood laws, which dictates the rules on publication of your vulnerability research. Knowingly publishing false information that causes damage is actionable and in many jurisdictions, illegal. Unless it is made absolutely clear that the vulnerability at issue is indeed historic and has been resolved by fixes already developed and distributed, your publication would absolutely be misleading.

Furthermore, mere assertions that Secunia has obtained our code in a legal manner do not in any way legitimize actions, which are in patent violation of our end user license agreements.

You are on notice regarding the foregoing and we expect that you will act accordingly and ensure that in the event you move forward with any publication, you specifically highlight that the vulnerability at issue is indeed historic and has been resolved by fixes already developed and distributed.
