In light of your correspondence of December 4, 2007, we cannot make any clearer our demand that Secunia withhold any publication regarding vulnerabilities in our software, unless it is completely balanced, accurate, truthful and in compliance with all applicable laws, absent our express prior written consent.


Unfortunately, in our experience, Secunia issues vulnerability advisories, which exaggerate threats, expose customers to incremental risk, fail to include all relevant information, or simply regurgitate already public information, purportedly for the benefit of the market generally, but which in reality amount to little more than self-serving publicity for Secunia.

Your suggestion that we deliberately hide or attempt to conceal security information regarding our products is entirely unfounded and without merit and is a clear example of the disingenuous and libelous hyperbole, which requires us to reiterate our demands. We have a long history and very successful track record of developing and supporting highly sophisticated software products designed to meet and exceed the needs of our clients, some of the largest and most sophisticated enterprises in the world.

Rather than pursuing a letter writing campaign, suffice to say that we will not tolerate any publications regarding our company, our products, our services or our practices, which violate our intellectual property rights, or which give rise to any cause of action in equity or at law. As with your prior correspondence, I have forwarded your last letter to our litigation counsel. While it is always our preference to resolve issues amicably, we are hopeful that you will ensure

that Secunia remains in full compliance with all of its legal responsibilities and obligations, including to our customers and ourselves.
