Large organisations are more exposed to vulnerabilities and, as you may have experienced, not all the tools on the market can handle the complexity and challenges of a large IT infrastructure.

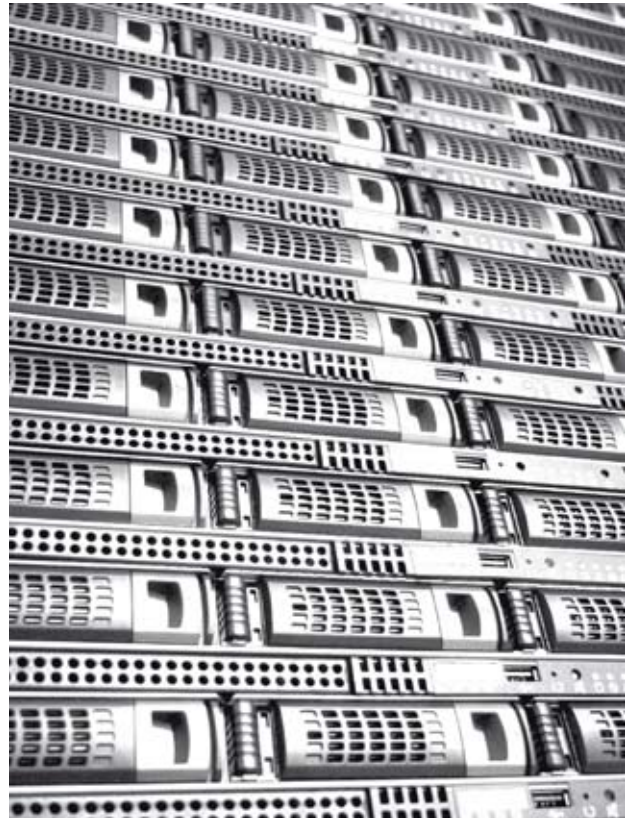

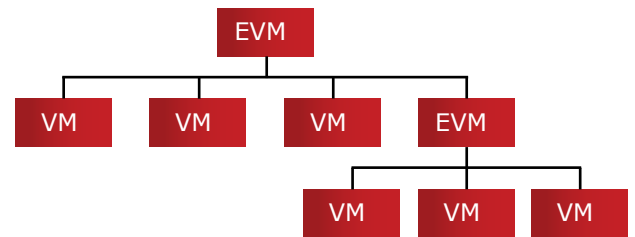

Optional

The EVM-S pulls intelligence directly from the Secunia Database through an encrypted HTTPS tunnel to your own server, without any exchange of information regarding local configurations.

All management, documentation, filtering, and distribution is conducted on your own server to accommodate even the strictest IT security policy.

Vulnerability alerts & advisories

All advisories are written in a uniform manner and are rated according to our highly acknowledged assessment scale. This helps you evaluate the criticality level of each advisory. Detailed vulnerability intelligence is issued via e-mail.

Alerts are issued via SMS to ensure that you are instantly notified on critical vulnerabilities. Advisories with full details are sent via e-mail. You can choose your own threshold levels for when you want to be alerted.
